Proposition 3: Californians for Safe Drinking Water and a Clean and Reliable Water Supply

Summary: Prop. 3 would authorize \$8.87 billion in general obligation bonds for water infrastructure and environmental protection projects – money that will be spent on, or in support of, scientists and scientific programs in multiple state departments.

Position: **SUPPORT**

Proposition 6: Voter Approval for Future Gas and Vehicle Taxes and 2017 Tax Repeal Initiative

Summary: Prop. 6 proposes to repeal SB 1, the Road Repair and Accountability Act, which provides \$5.2 billion annually to state and local transportation projects throughout California. Proposition 6 would jeopardize bridge and road safety, stop 6,500 transportation improvement projects already underway, and hurt job creation and the economy. CAPS believes the repeal of SB 1 would create new pressure on the state general fund and rainy day reserve, threatening scientific staff and programs now and during the next budget deficit.
