Re: Supervisory Classifications Pay

Dear Mr. Booth:

As you are aware, in 2008, former DPA Director Dave Gilb released a decision that fourteen supervisory scientific classifications were no longer aligned with other classifications based upon historical salary relationships. CAPS has worked hard to implement the both the April 28, 2008 decision and June 27, 2008 corrected decision. Since May 2008 CAPS has proposed to raise all remaining supervisory scientific classifications as well. It is in the state's interest to also maintain historical salary relationships within the scientific community.

The CAPS Supervisory Committee remains committed to the implementation of salary adjustments *across the board*. I have attached the last CAPS proposal and "Attachment A" describing salary adjustments sought for the remaining scientific classes.

The CAPS Supervisory Committee urges the CalHR to implement salary adjusts for all S10 designated classifications.
