This memorandum is to provide you information on actions we're taking in response to COVID-19. The Department cares about and is committed to protecting our employees, and we are taking steps to provide you with a safe work environment.

The Center for Environmental Health – Food and Drug Branch has learned that an employee at Santa Ana FDB office suite has tested positive for the COVID-19 virus. The employee was tested for the virus and received positive results of this test on June 11, 2020 and was last onsite on June 8. This email is to notify you that you may have been exposed to COVID-19. If you develop symptoms, i.e. fever, cough, sore throat, shortness of breath, contact your healthcare provider for guidance and any possible actions to take based on individual circumstances.

If you are subject to quarantine or self-monitoring from a local public health department, you will be provided with temporary telework and other leave/pay options will be considered, consistent with department policy.

As a reminder, while we understand that employees may have questions about the health of coworkers and friends in the office, it is necessary that we protect the health-related information of our employees. CDPH is working closely with the California Department of Human Resources (CalHR) and will share information and updates as they become available.
