



2020 FEDERAL LOCALITY PAY ADJUSTMENTS

- 15.95% Locality Pay for Counties in Dark Teal -- California and the rest of the US.
- 26.37% Locality Pay for Counties in Darkest Green -- includes Sacramento County.
- 41.44% Locality Pay for Counties in Bright Green includes Bay Area and surrounding counties.
- 32.41% Locality Pay for Counties in Mid-Level Green includes Southern California counties like Los Angeles. and Orange.
- 29.77% Locality Pay in Dark Green for San Diego County




GEOGRAPHIC COMPARISONS FROM 2020 TOTAL COMPENSATION REPORT

Geographic Comparisons

When comparing compensation, it is important to recognize that wages can vary between geographic regions. The federal government has a policy of paying its white-collar employees more to work in four regions of California (Sacramento, Los Angeles, San Francisco, and San Diego) than it does in the rest of the state.
